Forget everything you thought you knew about quiet white wines. The Sauvignon Blanc 2025 is not a quiet companion it is a statement. It is the moment when you bring a glass to your nose and the world around you stops for an instant because a whole basket of exotic fruits floods your senses. It is like a walk through a tropical garden right after a refreshing summer rain: intense, lively, and of incredible depth. This is a wine for explorers, for lovers of the extraordinary, who seek a wine with edges, corners, and unmistakable character.

Even the light golden color with greenish reflections signals its freshness. The bouquet is a true explosion: Intense aromas of lychee, pineapple, and passion fruit form the prelude, followed by the varietal, beloved gooseberry and a hint of freshly cut grass and green bell pepper. On the palate, it delivers what the nose promises. It is "racy" in the best sense of the word. The distinct acidity of 6,5 g/l forms the backbone and gives it an electrifying tension and length. The highlight is the off-dry tuning: The 4,6 g/l residual sweetness are the perfect counterpart to the acidity. They buffer the peaks and highlight the exotic fruit without ever seeming sweet. The result is a complex, multi-layered wine with a long, mineral finish.

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
